♦ Ingredients & effect	<div>  <p>Orange blossom</p>  <p>Shea nuts</p> </div> <p>1. Orange blossom water: donates skin natural moisture and restores the pH balance. It calms the skin and smoothes complexion. Especially for dry skin it acts cleansing and caring. Orange blossom water is wonderfully sweet and fresh scented, acts uplifting and dissolves stress.</p> <p>2. Shea butter: the Shea butter we use for our products is obtained traditionally without adding chemical additives. First, the Shea nuts are harvested and stored until the ideal level of maturity is reached. The nuts are stomped and the compound obtained is carefully heated up to 50 – 60 C the Shea butter melts, detaches from the paring and is then skimmed. While cooling down, Shea butter unrefined forms, a white yellowish compound with a light fat smell. Thanks to this very careful process the healing and caring substances are maintained.</p>
